Medina Hometown Hero Banner Application Requirements

All servicewomen and servicemen must have the following qualifications:

- 1. Reside in Medina, NY presently or at some time in their lifetime.**
- 2. Served or serving our country in one of the following: Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, Navy, National Guard, Space Force.**
- 3. Each serviceman and servicewoman must be presently serving, or have an honorable discharge from his/her duty, or MIA, or killed in the line of duty.**

Medina Hometown Hero Banner Information

Each banner will be 30 inches by 60 inches, double sided photo, vinyl material, and will include the following factual information:

Name of the serviceperson; their branch of service; rank; era of service and any honors received (No more than two will be stated on the banner). The new banners (2025) will be featured on poles located on Main, North Main and South Main, East and West Center, Park Avenue. They will be displayed before Memorial Day, 2025, and will be removed following Veterans Day 2025. At that point the banners will be stored in crates and placed in the DPW buildings. The 2025 banners will be displayed again in 2026 and 2027. Some sponsors have asked for special placement of their serviceperson's banner. The requests will be presented to Mary Woodruff since the DPW is quite busy doing their regular work. Your request will be listed but may not be able to be honored. The final year of new banners will be 2027 and you will be notified when your banner is ready to be picked up that year. If you need your banner mailed you will need to send a check to cover the charges. We paid for the mailings as a donation to MHHB but the price has now increased between \$14.00 to \$16.00

Pricing: A new banner will be \$200. This cost includes the hardware necessary to hang the banner and the banner itself. The price did increase but with generous and much appreciated donations, the price remains the same for new banners, If you are replacing a former banner for the next three year display the cost is \$120 since you have already purchased the hardware.
